The Employee Agrees and Understands That:

1. The Contra Costa Centre Association BART Subsidy Program is only offered to employees who are employed at a CCCA participating building site. Participating buildings are as follows: 2999 Oak Road, 3000 Oak Road, Avalon Walnut Creek Retail, Bank of the West, John Muir Health, Pacific Plaza, PMI Plaza, Station Landing/AAA, Station Plaza, Treat Plaza, Treat Towers, Urban West, Renaissance Club Sport, and Embassy Suites.
2. Employees must pledge to take BART to work at the Contra Costa Centre a minimum of three times a week.
3. Employees must not be receiving any other commute alternative subsidy from any other CCCA programs.
4. At the time of registering for the BART Subsidy Program, employee must present a valid form of identification and proof of their current employer.
5. Continued program eligibility requires monthly pick up of BART tickets. Employees who fail to pick up BART tickets for one month will be dropped from the program and the next available person on the waiting list will be called.
6. Employees must sign a BART Subsidy Program application and verify the BART ticket will only be used for the employee's sole purpose of commuting from their residency to their worksite at one of the participating buildings at the Contra Costa Centre. Residents of Pleasant Hill, Pacheco, Martinez, San Ramon, Danville, Alamo and Walnut Creek are not eligible.
7. On Tuesday, February 16, 2010, program applications will be accepted in the lobbies at either 2999 Oak Road or 1350 Treat Blvd., Walnut Creek, between 11:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. Thereafter, tickets will be available in the lobby at 1350 Treat Blvd., Walnut Creek, on Tuesdays only between 11:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.
8. No cash will be given in exchange for Commuter Checks.
9. This program is available on a first-come, first-served basis.
10. Employee agrees to inform the CCCA within five (5) working days if there is any change in employment, or be subject to repayment of subsidy(ies) to CCCA, including penalties and interest thereon.
11. The CCCA BART Subsidy Program is strictly voluntary. By signing this form, employee hereby releases and holds CCCA harmless from any and all liabilities, claim demands, damages and/or costs incident to or arising out of commuting by public transit. (Initialed by employee.)
