Are rising gas prices getting you down? Does it seem like you're pumping more and more of your hard-earned money directly into your gas tank? Gas prices are out of control and commute-related costs continue to climb.



BART Incentive Program For five months, beginning Tuesday, February 16, 2010, purchase one \$48 value BART ticket for \$35 each month through June 2010. The program is on a first-come, first-served basis for the first 200 eligible Centre employees responding. Participants must complete and submit program application and meet eligibility requirements stated therein. **You save: \$65!**



Carpool Incentive Program For five months, beginning Tuesday, February 23, 2010, the first 30 to form a new carpool will receive a \$25 Chevron gas card per carpool, per month for five months. After March 23 carpools formed prior to February 23 will be eligible on a first-come, first-served basis to meet program allotment. Participants must complete and submit program application and meet eligibility requirements stated therein. **You save: \$125!**



Bus Incentive Program For four months, beginning Tuesday, March 2, 2010, purchase one County Connection, Solano or Muni monthly bus pass and receive a reimbursement of up to \$30 each month through June 2010. The program is on a first-come, first-served basis for the first 15 eligible Centre employees responding. Participants must complete and submit program application and meet eligibility requirements stated therein. **You save: \$120!**



Bike-to-Work Incentive Program For four months, beginning Tuesday, March 2, 2010, bike to work a minimum of eight times per month and receive a one time \$48 BART ticket through June 2010. Program is on a first-come, first-served basis for the first 10 eligible Centre employees responding. Participants must complete and submit program application and meet eligibility requirements stated therein. **You earn: \$48!**



Vanpool Incentive Program For five months, beginning February 2010, be one of the first five to form a new vanpool and receive one \$100 Chevron gas card per vanpool, per month for five months. The program is on a first-come, first-served basis until the five vanpool slots are filled. Participants must complete and submit program application and meet eligibility requirements stated therein. **You save: \$500!**



Program eligibility and how to apply

The Contra Costa Centre Association's commute incentive programs are offered to employees who are employed at a CCCA participating building site. Participating buildings are as follows: 2999 Oak Road, 3000 Oak Road, Avalon Walnut Creek Retail, Bank of the West, John Muir Health, Pacific Plaza, PMI Plaza, Station Landing/ AAA, Station Plaza, Treat Plaza, Treat Towers, Urban West, Renaissance Club Sport, and Embassy Suites.

Employees are only eligible to participate in one commute incentive program for any given period of time. At the time of registering for any of the programs, the employee must present a valid form of identification and proof of their current employer.

All programs are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Participants must agree to inform the CCCA within five working days if there is any change in employment, or be subject to repayment of subsidy(ies) to CCCA, including penalties and interest thereon.

Additional program descriptions and eligibility requirements are outlined in each specific program application. Participants must complete and submit an application for each specific Contra Costa Centre Association incentive program and must meet any additional eligibility requirements stated therein.

To participate in any program, complete and return the application in person at the locations and on the dates as announced for the start of each program between 11:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.

Child Care Subsidy Program Have your child care costs

been increasing right along with rising gas prices? The Contra Costa Centre Association might be able to provide a little relief. The Centre's Child Care Program provides financial assistance to parents who must place their children from newborn to twelve years of age in a day care or after school setting while they are at work.

To be eligible to take part in the program, the parent must be employed, qualify and work at one of the participating buildings at the Contra Costa Centre Transit Village. Qualification for the program is based upon the following criteria: Participant's household income level must not exceed \$68,880 per year, full-time employment at one of the participating buildings at the Contra Costa Centre Transit Village that are listed below, and qualified need for child care.

The Child Care Program is available to employees at the following buildings whose property owners have funded the program: 2999 Oak Road, 3000 Oak Road, Avalon Walnut Creek Retail, Bank of the West, Embassy Suites Hotel, Pacific Plaza, PMI World Headquarters, Station Landing/AAA, Station Plaza, Treat Towers, and Urban West. The Centre does not have an on-site child care facility but can provide referral to child care providers near the workplace. **For more information and to fill out program application, contact the Contra Costa Centre Association at (925) 935-6337.**
