5.	Continued program eligibility requires either monthly pick up of bus tickets or submission of Requisition Reimbursement form and proof of bus ticket purchase. Employees who fail to pick up bus tickets or submit Requisition Reimbursement form for one month will be dropped from the program and the next available person on the waiting list will be called.
6.	Employees must sign this Bus Subsidy Program application to verify that the bus ticket will only be used for the employee's sole purpose of commuting from their residence to their worksite at one of the participating buildings at the Contra Costa Centre.

- If you haven't been pre-approved, applications will be accepted in person only on Tuesday, September 17th at Urban 7. West, 1350 Treat Blvd. between 11:30am and 1:00pm. After September 17th, subsidy payment and applications will be accepted on any Tuesday in the lobby at 1350 Treat Blvd., Walnut Creek, between 11:30am and 1:00pm.
